

### **Burnable Garbage**

- A certain number of "Minoh City designated bags for burnable garbage" are annually provided free of charge, depending on the number of your family members.
- The bags for burnable garbage provided this time are those that you may need by the end of September (If you moved to the City between January and June, or between July and December, you can receive the Bags for Burnable Garbage that you may need by the end of September this year, or the end of September next year, respectively.
- Around the beginning of every August, "an exchange postcard" for the bags for burnable garbage that you may need from October is sent to your house.
- Please exchange the postcard with the bags for burnable garbage at "a designated store."
   (See the attached list for details on the Stores.)
- If you need extra bags for burnable garbage, you must purchase them at your cost.
  (The bags for burnable garbage are available at designated Stores.)
- When you put out your bag for burnable garbage, please tie it in a cross-shaped knot. If the garbage doesn't fit in the bag, put it out as "large-sized garbage."



## Unburnable Garbage

2 bags per one collection.

- Please purchase "Minoh City designated bags for unburnable garbage" at your cost. (The bags are available at "designated stores.")
- When you put out your bag for unburnable garbage, please tie it in a cross-shaped knot. If the garbage doesn't fit in the bag, put it out as large-sized garbage.

## Dangerous Garbage

Please follow the rules as there is danger of explosion.

- Separate collection of the following is free of charge: lighters ,batteries ,clinical thermometers containing mercury ,fluorescent tubes ,spray cans and cassette-type gas cylinders.
- The lighters, batteries, clinical thermometers containing mercury —put into a clear bag. / fluorescent tubes —put into the empty box. / spray cans and cassette-type gas cylinders—put into the collection basket.

#### Large-sized Garbage

One item per one collection.

- Please purchase "a large-sized garbage ticket" at your cost. (The tickets are available at "designated stores.")
- One ticket or two tickets are needed for large-sized garbage with the longest side up to 1.5 m, and from 1.5 m to 3.0 m, respectively.

Isn't it still usable? How about repairing it? Think about them again!

#### **PET bottles**

They're collected and picked out for free to promote recycling.

- Separate collection of the following is free of charge: and put into the collection basket (Do not put them into plastic bags).
- Remove the cap and the label, and wash inside. (Caps and labels are burnable garbage)


#### **Empty cans, Glass**

They're collected and picked out free of charge to promote recycling.

- Separate collection of the following is free of charge: and put into the collection basket (Do not put them into plastic bags).
- Please bring newspapers, magazines, cardboard, old clothing, and paper containers to your community's Group Collection or to a Caravan Collection site (waste collection at public facilities in the City). ••• (Tel.724-6179)
